
In January the launch of our new year adoption promotion was timely, as we had to announce on January 5 that we were out of space, as both of our adoption buildings continued to be filled. With more dogs coming in through scheduled intake, emergency intakes, and Animal Enforcement pickups, any available kennels in our intake areas were soon filling up. When this happens, this leaves us with nowhere to put incoming pets in need.

82.6% TOTAL SAVE RATE

Save Rate = The percentage of animals who leave the shelter through adoption, return to owner, transfers to other organizations, or other lifesaving program

Thanks to our urgent pleas, and additional from network of support our vast volunteers, fosters, rescues, and media partners, we adopted out 396 animals, a nearly 10% increase from the previous year. Our promotional work also resulted in us reaching the milestone of 15,000 followers on the official BARC Instagram account!



COMPARING THE DATA

continue to see steady a increase in our adoption rates with 396 pets finding homes in January 2023 compared to 362 pets in 2022. Our rescue partners are starting the year with a higher number of pets being transferred, 835 pets were transferred to other organizations in January 2023 vs 680 in January 2022. In January we also saw an increase in pets who were fostered.
