I am pleased to support the the Memorial Drive Reconstruction Project from Tallowood to N Tealwood Drive, within the City of Houston. These improvements will increase the quality of life for residents in the area through improving this heavily trafficked street.

This project will reconstruct a portion of Memorial Drive from Tallowood Road to N Tealwood Drive, and will focus on a variety of safety, drainage, access, and efficiency improvements. These improvements include installing a raised median along the entire corridor, upgrading the existing sidewalk to the current City of Houston standard width, reconstructing the entire corridor from asphalt pavement to new concrete pavement, upgrading the traffic signal from span wire to mast arm at the intersection of Benignus Drive and Memorial Drive, installing pavement markings, crosswalks, and upgrading ADA ramps as needed along the entire corridor.
