

IAH Terminal Redevelopment Program (ITRP)






- Installed at IAH ecopark2 and HOU Garages

Current Conditions

- 3-lane entry on North Terminal Road.
- Multiple congestion points
 - Curbs
 - Pick-ups/drop-offs adjacent to travel lanes.
- Travel time of 14 minutes on C/D/E Loop.

(C Garage/C TNC alternate exit) HPD Placement: 14:30 – 21:30


3. C Departures Curb

Contract LEO Placement: 07:30-20:00


5. E South Arrivals Curb

Anticipated Improvements


- 4-Lane Entry on North Terminal Road
 - Will provide significant relief
- Removal of merge point
- Reduced congestion and delays
- Travel Time of ~ 8.5 minutes around
 C/D/E Loop (6-minute reduction)





December 2024 – Partial Opening of ICP Arrivals Curb


- Anticipated Improvements
 - 4-Lane Entry on North Terminal Road
 - Removal of merge point
 - Reduced congestion and delays
 - Partial opening of ICP Arrivals Curb provides relief on STR
 - Travel Time of ~ 8.2 minutes around
 C-D-E Loop (6-minute reduction)
 - Significant relief provided on NTR with
 4-Lane Entry







January 2025 – Full Opening of ICP Arrivals / Departure Curbs




Anticipated Improvements

- 4-Lane Entry on North Terminal Road
- Removal of merge point
- Reduced congestion and delays
- Full opening of ICP Arrivals and Departures Curb provides relief on STR
- Travel Time of ~ 6.4 minutes around
 C-D-E Loop (8-minute reduction)
- Significant relief provided on NTR with 4-Lane Entry
- Considers additional Terminal B loading at Terminal C with TBT Project underway





Late Summer 2025 – Completion of ICP / Final Traffic Configuration




Anticipated Improvements

- 4-Lane Entry on North Terminal Road
- Removal of merge point
- Reduced congestion and delays
- Full opening of ICP Arrivals and Departures Curb provides relief on STR
- Completion of decommissioning work on STR
- Travel Time of ~ 6.2 minutes around
 C-D-E Loop (8-minute reduction)
- Considers additional Terminal B loading at Terminal C with TBT Project underway




IAH Terminal A Restroom Renovation

\$30 Million Restroom Renovation Project

- IAH Terminal A
 - 18 Restrooms
 - 7 Family Restrooms
 - 1 Companion Care Changing Room
- IAH Terminal D
 - 5 Restrooms
 - 1 Restroom in Mother's Room
- IAH Sterile Corridor
 - 2 Restrooms
 - 1 Family Restroom

- HOU Phase 2 Restrooms:
 - Gates 20-23 December 2024
 - Gates 28-32 March 2025
 - Gates 24-27 July 2025
- HOU Phase 3 Restrooms:
 - RR 3-4 December 2024
 - RR 5-6 May 2025
 - RR 58-69 October 2025





\$35 Million Jet Bridge Project

- 80% FAA Grant Participation
 - \$28 million for 22 gates at IAH
 - \$7 million for 5 gates at HOU
- Replacing:
 - Passenger Loading Bridges
 - Ground Power Units
 - Preconditioned Air Units
- Project starts Nov. 4

Intuitive Machines Lands Another NASA Contract

- NASA awarded Intuitive Machines a 'Near Space Network' contract with maximum potential value of \$4.8 billion.
- Houston Spaceport anchor tenants now have over \$10 billion in contracts.
- Intuitive Machines is working to grow its workforce and needs to expand its facility footprint to support boost in labor.







Venus Aerospace is Developing Hypersonic Technology



- Developing the Stargazer Spaceplane.
- Company motto: "Home in Time for Dinner".
- Working on a proposed lease to expand its ongoing rotating detonation rocket engine.
- Working on supersonic test corridor over the Gulf of Mexico.





Houston Spaceport and the Future of Space City



- San Jacinto College is expanding its EDGE
 Training Center at the Spaceport.
- Texas A&M to break ground on Aerospace Institute near the Houston Spaceport.
- BVI Machining is moving to the Spaceport.

Carbon Accreditation Level 2 Achieved: Reduction



From 2019 to 2022, Houston Airports reduced emissions: IAH: 16% and HOU: 22%
