HOUSTON FORENSIC SCIENCE LGC, INC.

From May 1 working draft of LGC's Certificate of Formation:

"The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by [either seven or nine] Directors appointed by the City Council, as evidenced by a resolution approved by a majority vote."

"A majority of the Directors shall be residents of the City."

"In the aggregate, the Directors shall be **qualified to govern a forensic science center and to provide insight regarding forensic science issues from the perspectives of law enforcement, persons accused of crimes, and the general public.**"

From May 1 working draft of LGC's Certificate of Formation:

The initial terms of odd-numbered Directors will expire on June 30, 2015.

The initial terms of even-numbered Directors will expire on June 30, 2014.

After completion of the first term, the term of each Director will be three years.
