Houston Arts Alliance is contracted to provide professional services by the City of Houston's General Services Department and Houston Airport through the City's Percent-For-Art Ordinance. This ordinance identifies 1.75 % of eligible city capitol improvement project funds (only vertical projects above \$500,000.00) to be set aside for the aesthetic enhancement of public facilities and civic space, and conservation of existing works in the City of Houston Art Collection.
