IMPORTANT JUROR INFORMATION (Please Read Carefully)

FAILURE TO ANSWER SUMMONS AND PENALTIES

A person summoned for jury service who does not comply with the summons as required by law or who knowingly provides false information in a request for an exemption or to be excused from jury service is subject to a contempt action punishable by a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000. (Govt Code/Section 62.0141). Additionally, a juror lawfully notified shall be fined not less than \$100 nor more than \$500 if the juror: (1) fails to attend court in obedience to the notice without reasonable excuse; or (2) files a false claim of exemption from jury service (Govt Code, Section 62.111).

- Please arrive promptly to jury service and bring this summons with you to Court.
- Complete questionnaire below and submit to the Jury Administrator upon arrival.
- JURORS MUST PASS THROUGH BUILDING SECURITY AND METAL DETECTORS. Items not permitted include knitting/crochet needles, glass containers, weapons, knives (access the Court's website for complete list of prohibited items).
- Proper attire is required (shorts, tank tops, clothing with offensive graphics/messages are not permitted).
- Jury service at the City of Houston is typically one day only. Expect to spend a full day at jury service.
- You may bring a lunch on the day of your service. Lunch options provided by vendors and vending machines are available (no lunch vendor on Thursdays/Fridays).
- WIFI is available to jurors.
- Cell phones/electronic devices are allowed in the jury assembly room but not in the courtrooms. Cell phones must be on silent mode in the courtrooms.

FREE JUROR PARKING/LOT H: Free juror parking is available ONLY at the CITY OF HOUSTON "LOT H" located at the Southwest corner of Memorial Drive/Houston Avenue (Bordered by City of Houston Fonde Recreation Center, Memorial Drive, and the I-45 South on-ramp). Please confirm that you have parked in "LOT H" prior to leaving your vehicle to avoid being towed from an unauthorized lot or receiving a parking citation. The City of Houston is not responsible for any related towing/storage fees or parking citations incurred.

LOT "H" PARKING COUPON: Place the LOT "H" Parking Coupon above on your dash upon arrival at LOT H.

ALTERNATE PARKING (FEE REQUIRED): Jurors may park in the lot directly in front of the Courthouse (limited parking during peak hours of 8am-10am), at a meter, or surrounding private parking facility. If you choose an alternate parking option, you must pay the posted daily rate and follow all posted instructions.

ACCESSIBLE PARKING: A limited number of accessible parking spaces are available, at no charge, adjacent to the access ramp of the 1400 Lubbock courthouse. There are additional spaces, for the posted fee, in the lot directly in front of the courthouse (limited spaces from 8am-10am). You must display a valid placard/license plate.

<u>Right to Reemployment</u> (Civil Practice and Remedies Code, Section 122.001):

An employer may not discharge, threaten to discharge, intimidate, or coerce any permanent employee because the employee serves as a juror, or for the employee's attendance or scheduled attendance in connection with the service, in any court in the United States. An employee who is discharged, threatened with discharge, intimidated, or coerced in violation of this section is entitled to return to the same employment that the employee held when summoned for jury service if the employee, as soon as practical after release from jury service, gives the employer actual notice that the employee intends to return.
