

## PUBLIC NOTICE

The City of Houston, (City), through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD), Architectural Barrier Removal Program (ABRP) is seeking Contractors that are capable and desirous of serving as Independent Contractors (Repair Agency) to provide accessibility remodeling of single-family homes within the City of Houston. One (1) to ten (10) homes may be remodeled for Persons with Disabilities who need modifications to increase accessibility and eliminate hazardous conditions in their home. The ABRP is grant funded.

It is the responsibility of each contractor(s) to electronically generate and examine the entire RFQ, seek clarification in writing and review their submittal for accuracy before submitting questions relating to the RFQ.
