

Public Notice

The City of Houston (City) has been allocated \$23,486,698 in Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery funds to assist in recovery from the 2016 flood events (CDBG-DR16). This includes the following major disaster declarations: Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) DR-4269-TX (severe storms and flooding from April 17 – April 30, 2016 - the Tax Day Flood) and FEMA DR-4272-TX (severe storms and flooding from May 22, 2016 through June 24, 2016). To receive this funding, the City must submit an application to the Texas General Land Office (GLO). The application proposes that CDBG-DR16 funding be used for a Housing Buyout Program. The proposed Housing Buyout Program will fund the purchase of single family and/or multifamily properties, the relocation of residents, and the demolition of homes purchased.

A meeting will be held to present and receive public comment on the draft Housing Buyout Program Application on **Thursday, August 30, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. at the Lone Star College Victory Center, 4141 Victory Street, 77088.** The venue is accessible for persons with disabilities.
