

Public Notice

The City of Houston (City) through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD), is proposing a loan agreement between the City and Tejano Center for Community Concerns for \$1,560,000.00 in HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME) Funds land acquisition and construction costs for the new development of Sunrise Lofts, to be located at 3103 McKinney Street, Houston, TX 77003.

Sunrise Lofts will be an 89-unit permanent supportive housing development for young adults who are vulnerable, high risk, homeless and aging out of the foster care system. The Tejano Center was established in 1992 and has operated the youth shelter and foster care program at 5300 Sunrise since the mid 1990's in Houston's East End.

The public has thirty (30) days to comment on these proposed items. The thirty-day period extends from Thursday, May 06, 2021 through Saturday, June 05, 2021.
