

Public Notice

On Wednesday, Friday, June 23, 2017 the City of Houston (City), through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD) posted a Public Notice in the Houston Chronicle to identify and provide Community Development Block Grant- 2015 Flood Events (CDBG-DR15) funds to the Houston Public Works Department (HPW) for two Infrastructure Storm Water Action Team (SWAT) Projects.

The City is now proposing a Second Amendment to the Letter of Agreement (LOA) between HCDD and HPW for the two DR15 Infrastructure SWAT Projects to:

- Update language within the Agreement to ensure language is in alignment with the federal requirements
- Extend the performance period to September 30, 2023
- Perform a budget modification to transfer funds from Northside Northline SWAT 4A to Bonita Gardens SWAT 12A as seen in the below chart

The total cost of the infrastructure SWAT projects is estimated to be approximately \$29,039,325.00 of which **\$28,449,325.00** will be funded from the CDBG-DR15 Grant.

The budget modification is being performed based on the received and selected lowest bidders for both projects for the construction phase and due to projected construction cost overruns as of December 2021.

The public may comment on this proposed project during the 14-day comment period that extends from Monday, July 11, 2022 through Monday, July 25, 2022.
