

Public Notice

The City of Houston (City) through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD) is proposing a First Amendment to the Loan and Grant Agreement (Amendment) between the City and SEARCH Homeless Services (SEARCH) to include a Deed of Trust that contains provisions referencing the Restrictive Covenants. The City will release the lien on the property from SEARCH to allow for sale of the property between SEARCH and the Texas Department of Transportation of Transportation (TxDOT) to expand Interstate 45 Highway construction. No additional funding is being requested with this agreement. The property is in City Council District I.

The public has seven (7) days to comment on this proposed item. The seven-day period extends from Friday, March 15, 2024, through Thursday, March 21, 2024. Upon completion of the 7-day public comment period, HCDD will take this item to City Council.
