Public Notice

On Thursday October 24, 2024, the City of Houston (City) through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD) issued a public notice proposing a Second Amendment to the Developer Agreement (CHDO Single-Family Home Community Housing Development Program) (Agreement) between the City and A Caring Safe Place, Inc. (ACSP). The City is issuing a public notice correction, reflecting the following changes:

- i) Reduce the maximum amount of the agreement by \$554,000.00, from \$3,686,000.00 to \$3,132,000.00 in HOME funds
- ii) Reduce the total number of CHDO Homes that A Caring Safe Place, Inc. may build from thirteen to eleven
- iii) Amend cost projections
- iv) Extend the amount of time the Director may extend the time of performance
- v) Change provisions regarding definitions, CHDO Proceeds, Recapture Requirements, the affordability period, and sales contracts; and,
- vi) Replace the forms of the Homebuyer HOME Statement, Homebuyer Note, and Homebuyer Deed of Trust

The CHDO Single-Family Home Development Program administers newly constructed affordable-family homes for sale to eligible low- and moderate-income homebuyers and expands nonprofit housing providers' capacity.

This does not alter the original 30-day comment period. The 30-day comment period extended from Thursday, October 24, 2024, through Saturday, November 23, 2024. Upon completion of the 30-day public comment period, HCDD will take these items to City Council.
