

Public Notice

The City of Houston (City) through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD), is proposing an amendment to the allocation of U.S. Department of Labor Community Project Funding (DOL-CPF) funds, up to the amounts designated below, for the following participating agencies in its Public Services Program. The original budget allocation published on June 6, 2024, has been revised, noting a decrease in award amount for previously participating agency Launch Point CDC, Inc. which is being reallocated to current participating agencies. There is no fiscal change to the original total budget allocation.
