- No Parking on residential streets after 8 PM except with valid permit
- · Permits available for residents with proof of address in the corridor
- Limit of 3 permits per property



Permits

- Annual permits available with corridor address
- · Limit of 3 permits per property
- Need state issued ID
- Proof of residence
- No change to RPP regulations
- CPP permits are not valid in RPP zones

Garbage Pick Up Day



- No parking zone on Tuesday from 7AM – 12 Noon
- Parking only permitted with valid CPP or RPP permit



Approved by City Council in 2019, the Community Parking Program (CPP) allows ParkHouston to use the most effective tools for managing the limited number of on-street parking spaces in mixed-development neighborhoods. Those tools include:

- Parking Permits
- Parking Meters
- Time-limited Zones

Curbside parking spaces are in high demand. The goal of the CPP is to limit long-term parking and encourage turnover of those spaces.
