Public Comments	There were no public speakers
Financial Update	<p>The total payout to the Parking Benefit District (PBD) since the inception of the program has been \$91,845 of which the Committee has expended 10,000 on the bike rack project.</p> <p>The city's share has been \$61,230 of net meter revenue from the inception of the program.</p> <p>The projection is that the PBD will have a payout of \$10,609 post expenses.</p> <p>There has been a trend of a decrease in revenue in the PBD after the introduction of car share services.</p> <p>The committee members discussed additional areas that should be reviewed for installation of parking meters.</p>

Bike Rack Installation	<p>Bike racks have been installed at 3900 Washington, 1000 Asbury and 2200 Washington.</p> <p>The Committee was asked to recommend additional locations.</p>
Proposed Projects	<p>The Committee was presented with a list of proposed projects and their estimated costs. They discussed their preference for projects that promoted walkability and mobility.</p> <p>An online survey will be sent to Committee members to allow them to rank their choices for the next PBD project.</p>
Committee Member Comments	<p>The next Cigna Sunday Streets will be held in the fall on Washington Avenue.</p>
