

Modification

- Based on the feedback from staff and stakeholders, applications may be modified:
  - Boundary
  - District rules

Action

Planning Commission

- Requires majority support from respondents to establish a public hearing
- Considers based on 5 guiding principles

City Council

- Approve
- Refer back to Planning Commission
- Deny

## Questions from Previous Meeting

- Boundary requirement
  - Must be contiguous boundary without holes
  - Proposed boundary encourages consistent urban form
  - Logical boundary
- Size requirement
  - No minimum & maximum limitations
- Threshold of commercial activities
  - None
- Delay Implementation for Residential Parking Permits
  - o No
- Rules applied to all properties
  - Property owners may request variances from the rules if needed


